## F1 Air and BMW Team PTG Win at Barber Motorsport Park, Birmingham, AL

Birmingham, AL - July 31, 2005 Justin Marks and Joey Hand scored another GT-class win for F1 Air and BMW Team PTG today, after a breathtaking last-lap pass in slippery conditions at Barber Motorsport Park, outside Birmingham, AL. On a day on which rain brought a respite from the murderous humidity of Alabama, Joey Hand watched the track get soaked by a squall, then slowly dry back out with time expiring. He passed GT-class points leader David Murry under heavy braking with only one lap left in the two-hour, forty-five minute race to close the gap in the driver's championship and extend PTG's team points lead. Ian James and Chris Gleason, driving the #22 PTG BMW, finished third in the race, while RJ Valentine and Kelly Collins, driving the #17 F1 Air/PTG BMW M3, finished a strong 6th place on the weekend, helping place three PTG cars in the top 6.

"It's another win for F1 Air!," exclaimed RJ Valentine. "Watching Joey make that pass was a great moment for the PTG boys, and being part of another winning effort from this team and for F1 Air is a great thrill. We've had an incredible weekend - the BMW M3 prepared by PTG suits this track so well."

"It's unbelievable to think how many times we've been on the podium this year. My stint was about 50 minutes in the car, and it was constant action on the track. This facility is meant as a motorcycle track, and it's absolutely beautiful. It's a bit narrow for such a big field, and it's a constant battle having to race the GT cars for position while watching out for the hard-charging DPs."

He continued, "It's been a dream season so far with PTG. Tom Milner is a total professional - he calls all the shots, and he calls them right. The equipment is absolutely phenomenal, and I'm totally thankful to the crew for preparing them so well, as well as to my co-driver Kelly Collins for being a great teammate. I'm excited to get back to the Glen in August!"

RJ Valentine, F1 Air and the Grand American Rolex Sports Car Series race next on August 11-12 at Watkins Glen International in upstate New York. The race will be broadcast on Speed Channel.
